

Nov. 7th, 2019- Docks and Rebuilding

- Drone Mapping:
 - Aerial maps will be utilized in the debris removal as well as rebuilding process
 - This information will be used to identify and monitor progress on debris removal areas as well as identify structures that are damaged, in progress or still in tact to prioritize in the rebuilding
 - Lubbers, debris staging areas, and Hope Town Harbour have been mapped and the data is currently being processed
 - The comprehensive mapping of Elbow Cay is in the process

- Samaritan's Purse:
 - SP has been conducting homeowner assessments for a Muck and Guts service. This process is as follows:
 - SP representative will go with the homeowner who has requested their services and make an assessment of needs on the property
 - The homeowner will then have to sign a release stating that SP has permission to make an intervention on the property and set a date for work to take place
 - SP personnel will provide labour and remove debris, drywall, insulation, etc. depending on identified need
 - Debris will be placed on the roadside for later removal by SP or Hope Town United cash for work crews

- Building Materials:
 - Needs lists are being put together by "Home Depot" volunteers for building materials to be distributed as they arrive
 - The first shipment of peel and stick, ice and water shield last Thursday, November 7th and is currently being distributed
 - To be added to building material distribution lists, visit or contact our "Home Depot" location and make a request, including:

 3. Details on the kinds of building materials and amounts required
 - We are hoping to have another shipment of ice and water shield, accompanied by shipments of plywood and dimensional lumber arriving in the coming weeks, we have reached out to the various funding organizations to help in the cost of materials and shipping
