

Nov. 11th, 2019- Donated Supplies

- Used generator oil can be delivered to the Home Depot location for safe storage and disposal
- There are currently priority lists for receiving building supplies when they arrive
 - The three lists are for 1) Ice & Water Shield 2) Plywood/Lumber 3) Generators
 - To be placed on any of these lists visit or contact our on island "Home Depot" with your needs and amounts required
- Please note that Ice & Water shield is not intended for short term roof repairs, there is heavy duty tarping material also available at the Home Depot for this purpose
- To receive donated supplies, visit the Home Depot location during operating hours of 8am-12pm MWF and put in your request
 - If the item is on hand, you will receive it on sight
 - If the item is in warehouse storage, one of our home depot staff will retrieve it for you, or supply a written note that can be taken to the warehouse to retrieve the requested items
 - We are asking that tools and other multiple use items be returned when you are done with them so that they can be available for others in need
 - The reason for this is for our warehousing volunteers to keep an accurate accounting and inventory of items leaving the warehouse. This allows us to better inform donors of our current needs and inform the community of current supply stock
- There has been an expressed need for coordination of all necessary aspects of home repair (i.e. plywood, Ice & Water Shield, roofing nails, shingles, labour) to actually complete projects
 - While it would be nice to have all of the pieces come together at the same time, it is logistically and financially more efficient to source and ship supplies in bulk and have them come in sequentially
